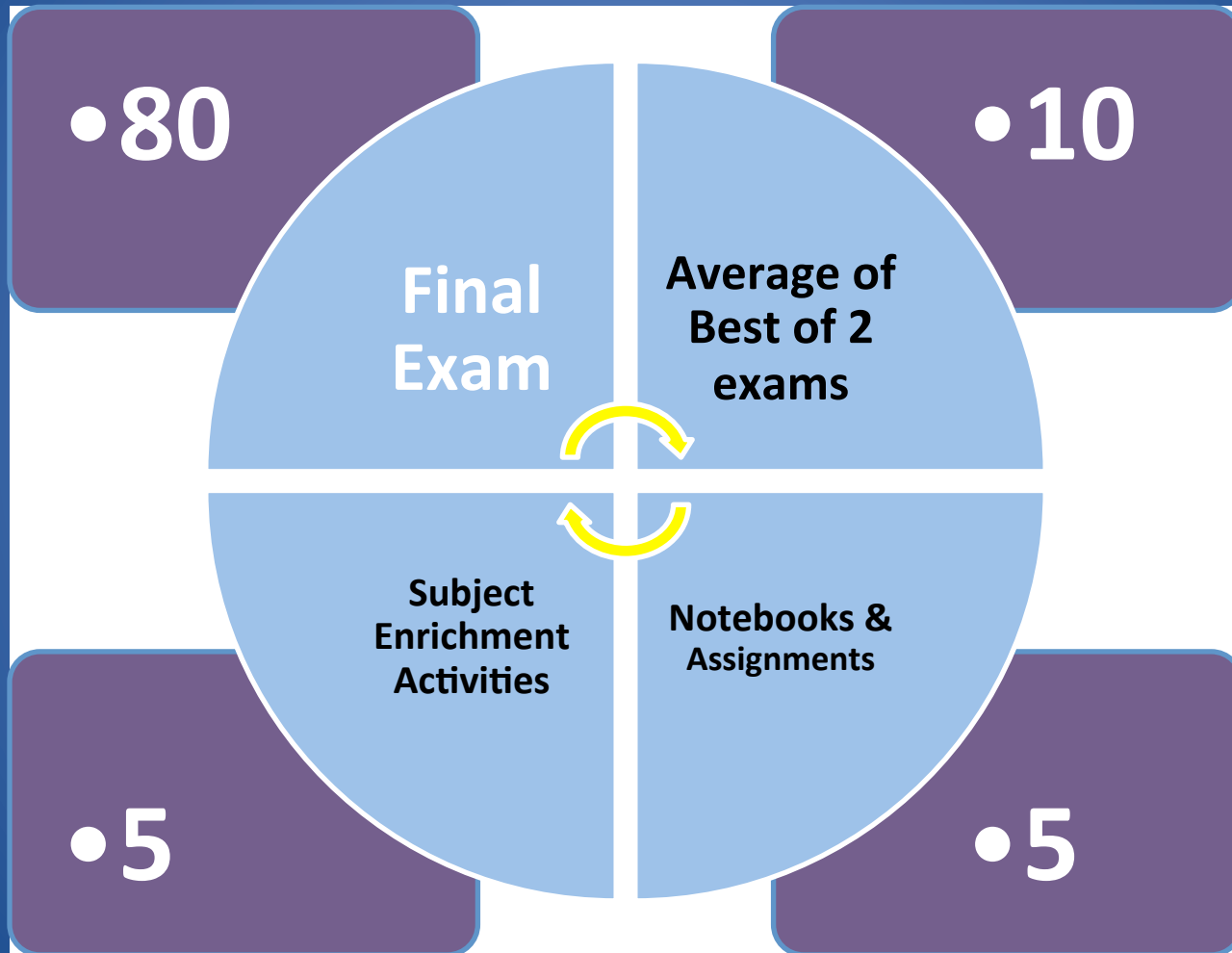

# CBSE IX & X- FAQ'S

-Do we have semester pattern for Class IX & X ?

There is no semester pattern for Class IX & X. It is cumulative portions in the Annual Exam

-What is cumulative portion?

In the Annual exam of Class IX and the Board exam of Class X, the student will have 100 % portions of the year. He / She will be appearing for 80 marks written paper covering 100 % syllabus.

-How many tests will be conducted during the year before the Annual exam / Board exam?

There will be 3 formal written test conducted before the Annual / Board exam. They are Pre midterm, Midterm and Post midterm. There will be cumulative portions in each exam. Each exam will cover syllabus covered till the exam from the start of the academic year.

-How is the marking pattern in the Annual / Board exam?

The Annual / Board exam will have 2 components

I- 80 marks written exam- 33 % required for passing

II- 20 marks made up of the following:

a) 10 marks from best of the two exams (pre midterm, midterm and post midterm) in each of the subject

b) 5 marks for Notebooks and assignments awarded by the subject teacher in each subject

c) 5 marks for Subject enrichment activities conducted by the subject teacher during the year

-So the Results of Class IX & X will reflect marks out of 100 ?

Yes, total of component I and II as mentioned in Point 4

33 % marks are needed in both 80 and 20 marks component to pass

-What if a student remains absent in any of the three test conducted by the school?

There is no provision for a re-test. The student will be marked absent. The student can benefit from the fact that the final scores will reflect best of the two marks in the subject. So even if the student scored zero in any test, the marks of the other two tests will make up for the loss.

-What is the present status of second language?

As of now there is no change. Any change in future will not affect the status of the present Class IX & X lot.

-What is the difference between the new and the old pattern?

There will be no FA or SA and there will be 100 % syllabus in the end, unlike SA which had only 50 % syllabus.
