On behalf of the Executive Committee and the school administration, we express our sincere thanks and gratitude for the support and the cooperation extended to us in all our endeavors.

We would like to bring to your kind attention about a case filed in the Supreme Administrative Court, Kingdom of Bahrain, by a parent, who has contested and lost in the last election, against the Ministry of Education's (MOE) decision to extend the term of the present Executive Committee due to the prevailing conditions. The case was filed against the MOE, the Indian School and 11 Executive Committee members.

Kindly be updated on the case and the judgment.

- The lawsuit was pleading to dismiss the current Executive Committee and appoint the complainant (plaintiff) and the other candidates who lost in the election held in 2017, as the new members of the Executive Committee, even if temporarily, until the next elections are held.
- 2) The petition was also pleading to conduct the elections for the Executive Committee as soon as possible, in accordance with the provisions of school's constitution through the usual methods of elections.
- 3) The Honorable Supreme Administrative Court has issued the judgement in the public hearing held on 28.04.2021.
- 4) The judgement states that "The court ruled with rejecting the case, and obligated the plaintiff to pay the expenses and an amount of twenty dinars against the attorney's fees".

We request your continued support and cooperation to ensure the stability of our school as well as to provide the best possible education to our children during these challenging days of the pandemic.
